

## **BIRTHDAYS**

Every now and then someone yells out that we have not included them in the Birthday list or draw.

That used to happen once in a while before Heather Kerber was appointed as our Membership Officer.

Now we read pre-prepare the lists carefully from our membership database to avoid missing anyone out.

We read out names of those whose birthday is in the period from the day after our previous show and today’s show. These are all included in the Birthday draw.

We also read out names of members whose birthday is the next *7 days*. These are not included in the Birthday draw. Anyone who is unfinancial at the time may be read out, but will not be in the draw.

If we have missed anyone out the most probable reason is that you have not written your birthdate on your Membership form.

**You know the three simple rules: Be a member, be financial and be there at the time of the draw.**

## **ORDERING MEALS AND DESSERT**

There are still some occasions where patrons are not using the meal ordering forms properly.

This creates confusion during delivery, and it bothers me that some people get angry at the volunteers who try to deliver your meals or dessert.

There are only two basic rules here (or three):

1. Table numbers must be written on your order form. Orders will no longer be accepted without them.
2. When you order you receive a raffle ticket with a number on it. This number is used to identify the person at the table for delivery. From now on you must have that number to receive your order. If its missing you may not get your meal or dessert.

While I appreciate some people do lose their tickets, I will not tolerate any hostility directed to our volunteers.

Consider yourselves warned.

## **REMINDER: WALKER SAFETY**

- Space – they take up a fair bit of room, so you need to be careful where you park them. Need to strike a balance between your immediate needs and the ability of others to move around you while you are seated. I’ve heard of places where walkers are moved out of the room and only retrieved when called for. Don’t want to go this far, so be mindful of others around you, especially if you are seated near thoroughfares.
- Parking Brakes. When you’re not using your walk, apply the parking brakes. This will prevent them from scooting away if someone accidentally contacts it, which may cause them to have a fall. And we all know that falls are the number one injury in our age group.
